Member companies share TFBI's network of industry contacts and this provides the opportunity for rapid progress.

Members using the facility located the heart of the vibrant, competitive, Toronto commercial market, gain the distinct advantage of being uniquely positioned to directly observe, test and uncover a wide range of marketing, distribution and point-of-sale methods.

The TFBI currently offers 3 levels of programming:

- An Introductory Seminar for those who would wish to start a food business
- A Pre-Commercial Program for companies new to the food sector or people with a background in food that are new entrepreneurs.
- A Commercialization Program for small established companies that are seeking to build sustainable businesses through the mass manufacture of food products

Companies participate for a period of up to 3-years and then receive assistance in migrating to independent food production facilities.
